Hay, hay, and more hay was the theme of the hay sale this past Saturday, 1/12/19. The consignors did not disappoint on the selection and quality; there was something for every feed program and budget! It was a warm, dry, beautiful day for a January hay sale here in Minnesota! We had lots of first-time buyers that were able to purchase some good hay for all of their needs.

The day started with basic quality grass small square bales that on average brought \$3.50 a bale. The small squares continued to bring prices on average of \$5.25 for nice grass/alfalfa mix hay. Top-end green grass/alfalfa small square bales demanded a strong market at \$7.00-\$8.25. Small square bales of straw held steady on average of \$4.00 per bale.

Large square bales of grass started on average at \$80 per bale. Trending up to \$95 for grass/alfalfa mix, and topped off at \$110 for premium horse-quality alfalfa. Round bales of cattle/livestock quality sold on average at \$65-70 per bale, with larger average quality rounds at \$80-\$85 per bale. No test on high-end alfalfa rounds.
